Early Musical Theater Ages: 4 – 8

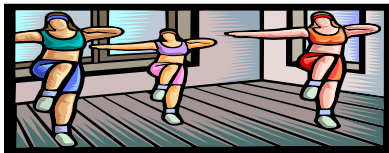
